**SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)**

Petitioner, who is a borrower, is assailing one of the recourses adopted by the Tehsildar, Moga, under Section 13(4) of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, (for short 'the SARFAESI Act') and further the possession notice dated 16.09.2025 (Annexure P-5) issued by the Tehsildar, Moga, is also under challenge and various disputed questions of fact are being raised.

2. The petitioner has an alternative efficacious statutory remedy under Section 17 of the SARFAESI Act, which can very well be availed, therefore, this Court declines interference.

3. With the aforesaid liberty, this petition stands disposed of.
