The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 09.10.2017.

Respondents, accordingly complied with the aforesaid order by way of passing of a speaking order dated 14.12.2017. However, on the last date of hearing, this Court noticed that the order passed by the Writ Court had not been complied with in letter and spirit as videography of the running competition was not referred to by the concerned authority. Accordingly, additional affidavit dated 16.07.2018 of Sh. Mahavir Kaushik, Secretary, HPSC has been filed clarifying that HPSC was not conduct any videography of running competition but venue was under the gaze of CCTV cameras which were installed for security reasons as well as for creating visual proof qua the candidates in question so that they may not impersonate. Further, the timing shown by scientific instrument RFID is more authentic which was applied and used as per Rule 12.16 Clause 5(a) of the amended Punjab Police Rules, 2015.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed accordingly.

In case, the petitioner is aggrieved by passing of the said order, he is at liberty to challenge the said order, in accordance with law.
