1. In the present petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 10.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) whereby, the case of the petitioner for grant of compassionate appointment has been declined on the ground that the petitioner being married daughter is not covered under the Compassionate Appointment Policy/Instructions dated 21.11.2002.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2-PSPCL has very fairly stated that in fact an amendment has been made in the Policy dated 21.11.2002 on 29.01.2024 whereby, the petitioner has been made eligible for

grant of compassionate appointment. He further submits that the case of the petitioner will be reconsidered in accordance with the amended policy for the purpose of compassionate appointment.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement given by learned counsel for respondent No.2, the present writ petition may be disposed of and a direction to respondent No.2 may be issued to decide the case of the petitioner in a time bound manner for the purpose of grant of compassionate appointment.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in accordance with law preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
