HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for willful disobedience of order dated 08.11.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-11438-2011.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that Rs.8,50,000/- has been released in favour of the petitioner. He further informs that detailed calculation with regard to the benefits payable to the petitioner has been supplied to the learned counsel representing the petitioner and the compliance stands made.

In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to challenge the calculations submitted by the respondents by making a detailed representation within a period of two weeks from today which shall be considered and decided by respondents within a period of four weeks thereafter and response thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioner within two weeks.
