Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.296 dated 16.4.2024 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal.

2. The petitioners were granted interim bail with direction to join investigation by this Court vide order dated 12.9.2024 wherein it was observed that primarily, the dispute between the parties is regarding breach of the terms and conditions of the agreement (Annexure P-5).

3. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined investigation with the police and further, now the matter has been compromised between

the parties in the mediation proceedings and the petitioners have already filed compromise quashing petition bearing CRM-M-556-2025 which is now fixed for 24.2.2025.

4. State counsel on instructions from SI Sulinder Singh submits that indeed, the petitioners have joined investigation with the police and should join further investigation as and when called to do so by the police officials.

5. Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has admitted the fact that now the matter has been compromised between the parties and compromise quashing petition is already filed by the petitioners.

6. Counsel for the complainant further expressed no objection if the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 12.9.2024 is made absolute.

7. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 12.9.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. It is further made clear that the petitioners should join further investigation as and when called to do so by the police.
