The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix the pay of the petitioner in terms of Rule 7 (1) of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Scale of Pay) Rules, 1980 which came into force w.e.f. 01.04.1979 and fix the petitioner in the pay of Rs. 730/- instead of 700/- and consequently further re-fix the pay from time to time and also the retiral benefits i.e. pension, gratuity, leave encashment and grant all monetary benefits i.e. difference between the amount due and amount already paid alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

2 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioners would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the demand/Legal Notice



dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 On the asking of the Court, Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.3 –the Executive Engineer, Provincial Division, Public Works Department (B&R) Haryana Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani is directed to take note of the demand/Legal Notice dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) sent by the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6 Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of four months.
