1. Instant petition under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) has been preferred seeking directions to the respondent-State to initiate the proceedings against respondent No. 6.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner got registered the FIR No. 0020, dated 04.03.2024, under Sections 302 IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot, but till date investigation has not been conducted in an impartial manner and has moved representation dated 03.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot, Punjab. But no decision on the said application has been taken till date.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 4 and submits that the aforesaid representation shall be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner according to the law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankkot, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 03.08.2024 (Annexure P-4), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
