The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 2.4.2018, vide which direction was issued to decide the legal notice dated 20.2.2018 within three months.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Dr.Rakesh Gupta, Director General School Education, Haryana, Panchkula dated 4.2.2019 has been filed. It is stated in para 8 of the reply that the whole process involves 1,10,000 employees. The information/exact data of the employees is to be collected from the field offices, which is a lengthy and bulky task. The information can be collected only on the basis of salary bills issued by the different Drawing and Disbursing Officers spread over the State. Detail of the efforts has been mentioned in para 8 and 9 of the reply. It is requested that two months' time be granted to finalize the seniority with respect to the persons with disabilities and further one month's time too be granted to consider the case of the petitioner thereafter.

Request for time is genuine.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to comply with the order dated 2.4.2018 within three months from today.

In case, the needful is not done within the stipulated period, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
