DEEPAK GUPTA, J.

Petitioner herein is the defendant before learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Kaithal in Civil Suit bearing CIS No.341 of 2018 titled as "***Sunita Ahuja v. Krishan Kumar***". He is aggrieved by the order dated 16.05.2025 (*Annexure P-4*), whereby his application for recalling PW1 - Vinod Kumar & PW 2 - Sunita Ahuja for re-cross examination, has been dismissed.

2. Petitioner is appearing in person and has been heard at considerable length.

3. A perusal of the impugned order would reveal that suit for specific performance was filed in March, 2018 by the plaintiff - Sunita Ahuja, i.e. respondent herein. Issues were settled on 28.09.2018. Plaintiff had closed her evidence on 23.12.2021. The trial Court further noticed in the impugned order that after closure of the evidence of the plaintiff, the matter was adjourned as many as 12 times, granting effective opportunities to the defendant, *i.e. petitioner herein* to produce his evidence, but he failed to do so.

4. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the trial Court did not commit any illegality in rejecting the application of the petitioner-defendant to recall PW1 and PW2 for their further cross-examination, in the absence of any plausible reasons.

5. As such, finding the present revision petition to be devoid of any merit, the same is hereby dismissed.
