1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 29.12.2024 (Annexure P-9) whereby he has been posted at Sub Office, Manimajra, Chandigarh on his substantive post of Beldar.
2. The petitioner claims that he is holding substantive post of Beldar, however, is eligible to the promotional post of Driver. For last many years, he is discharging duty of Driver.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sharma submits that he does not press his prayer *qua* quashing of impugned order, however, prays that respondent may be directed to consider his case for promotion.
4. In the light of limited prayer, this Court does not find it appropriate to issue notice of motion and seek response of the respondent.
5. Without expressing opinion on merits, the petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent to consider claim of petitioner for promotion, in accordance with law, within 6 months from today.
