1. Instant petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.154, dated 11.11.2024, under Sections 22, 27, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Anaj Mandi, District Patiala. Further prayer has been made for staying the arrest of the petitioner during the pendency of the present petition.

2. Vide order dated 14.05.2025, while granting the interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.05.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 14.05.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS.
