LAPITA BANERJI, J. (Oral)

In this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for transfer of arms license bearing No.2142/DM/SNP/1999 dated 02.07.1999 (Annexure P-1) in the name of the petitioner's father to the name of the petitioner under the Family Heirloom Policy and Rule 25 of the Arms Rules, 2016.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the Family Heirloom Policy of the Government. He submits that petitioner has made an application on January 2, 2025 and deposited the necessary fee.

3. Issue notice to the respondents.

4. Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He submits that a final decision can be taken by the competent authority on the application filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the material on record.



6. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this Court directs that the application of the petitioner dated January 2, 2025 be decided by the competent authority within a period of 3 months from the date of this order.

7. With the directions aforesaid, CWP 4760 of 2025 is **disposed of.**

8. Connected applications, if any, are accordingly disposed of.
