Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRWP-11050-2024 titled as “Gaurav Dutta vs. State of Punjab and others”.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State files the Compliance Report dated 07.5.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Aditya, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, which is taken on record.
