1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.186 dated 06.09.2025 under Sections 21(b), 27(a) of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.
2. Learned State counsel has apprised a fact which the learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to rebut that there are two more NDPS cases registered against the petitioner, in one of which the recovery effected from him was 53 kgs of poppy husk while in the other it was 10.2 grams, in view of which though, after arguing for some time, he, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court but makes a prayer that his bail application be directed to be decided within a time-bound manner.

In view of the prayer made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court that in case the petitioner surrenders within a period of seven days from today and files an application for grant of bail, the same be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.
