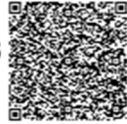

(1) Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Patiala to take a decision on the legal notice dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) served on behalf of the petitioner.

(2) Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above prayer is accepted.

(3) Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Deputy Commissioner, Patiala to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice served on behalf of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order and
