Petitioner has filed the instant contempt petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 for proceeding against the respondent for violating the order dated 21.10.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No.22780 of 2015 wherein the respondents were directed to decide the representation dated 11.06.2015 moved by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order dated 21.10.2015.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Anil Kumar Deputy Director, O/o DPI (Colleges), Punjab submits that the due payments have been released to the college for disbursement to the petitioner.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is some minor dispute regarding the calculations and increments qua which the petitioner be given liberty to file representation.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
