Notices issued to respondents have been received back duly served but there is no representation on behalf of the respondents.

2. The petitioner who is a complainant in complaint bearing No. NACT /434/2020 titled as '*M/s Sampoorna Feeds Pvt. Ltd. M/s Global Broilers Global Poultry and another*' as pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has challenged the order dated 04.01.2025 passed in the said case, whereby prayer made by the petitioner for transfer of the complaint, had been dismissed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of order dated 03.02.2025 passed in CRM-M-4073-2025, 4079-2025, 4292-2025 and 4084-2025, whereby four other complaints as filed by the present petitioner were ordered to be transferred to the same Court, to which some other complaints as pending between the parties were previously transferred.



It is submitted that since all the complaints filed by the present petitioner have been transferred to one Court, therefore, the aforementioned complaint may also be ordered to be transferred so that both the parties to the petition do not face any problem. Though on a perusal of the impugned order dated 04.01.2025, it is revealed that the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate had declined the prayer made by the present petitioner for transfer of the case as certain aspersions against the trial Magistrate had been cast, however, since the prayer for transfer of a particular complaint has been made before this Court only on the ground that all the other complaints of parties have been transferred to a particular Court, this Court is of the opinion that the interest of justice would be served, if criminal complaint No. 434 of 2020 titled as '*M/s Sampoorna Feeds Pvt. Ltd. M/s Global Broilers Global Poultry and another*', is ordered to be transferred to the same Court, where the other complaints between parties were transferred.

4. Ordered accordingly.
5. The petition is disposed of.
6. Since the main petition has been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
