1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against respondent for non-compliance of order dated 18.01.2011 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP-3705-2009, in view of order dated 16.08.2022 passed by the Supreme Court in Contempt Petition © No.399 of 2020 (Annexure P-5).

2. In compliance of order dated 18.01.2011 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP-3705-2009, the counsel for the State has filed copies of certain receipts of payment made to the petitioners, which are taken on record.

3. The counsel for the respondents-State has submitted that the order qua which the contempt was asserted, has since been complied with. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unaddressed, they will be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
