1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 12.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-26306-2016**, titled as '**Raj Kumar Chhabra vs. Insurance Ombudsman and others**' directing the respondent to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner expeditiously and preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of copy of the order stands duly complied with; and appeal of the petitioner was decided vide order dated 27.11.2020 (Annexure R-1). It is accordingly prayed that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of, as such.
