1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia* seeking directions to the respondents to grant the benefit of Dearness Allowance in accordance with recommendations of the 6th Punjab Pay Commission and as per All India Consumer Price Index dated 23.09.2015 (Annexre P-1).
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Puru Jarewal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that the petitioners shall be satisfied if, at this stage, directions are issued to the respondents to decide representation of the petitioners dated 31.07.2025 (Annexure P-30) within a time bound manner.



5. Learned counsel for the respondents does not oppose the said prayer.

6. In view thereof and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 31.07.2025 (Annexure P-30), within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Needless to say that the representation shall be decided after giving due notice and opportunity of hearing to the petitioners and by passing a speaking/reasoned order.

8. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
