1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the respondent No.2 to conduct the fair and impartial investigation by some higher police official in case arising out of FIR No. 81, dated 27.10.2024, under Sections 105,3(5) of B.N.S, registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 20.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the

petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural), to look into representation dated 20.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
