1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.08 dated 01.02.2025 registered under Sections 74, 190, 191(3), 305 & 331(1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda.
2. As per office report, notice could not be issued to respondent No.2/complainant for want of process fee. However, in the connected petition bearing CRM-M No.13237 of 2025 (Kirna Kaur @ Parneet Kaur @ Kiranjeet Kaur and another Vs. State of Punjab and another), respondent No.2/complainant has been served and none has put in appearance on her behalf.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 19.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdev Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 23.03.2025 and are no more required for further investigation.
