The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 BNSS read with Article 21 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondent to expedite the trial of the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 21.08.2020, registered under Sections 148/149/307/302 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 120-B and 216 of IPC added later on), at Police Station Sector-9, District Gurugram as the same is pending before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram.

2. Notice served upon the official respondent through State counsel. Given the nature of order this Court purposes to pass, no response is required from the State.

3. State counsel submits that earlier vide order dated 15.10.2024 (Annexure P-4), this Court had requested the trial Court to expedite the matter and no further order is required to pass.

4. Given the prayer of petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a request to trial Court to take up this matter on priority basis and State is requested not seek unnecessary adjournments. It is clarified that if petitioner seeks an adjournment, this order shall be recalled automatically. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
