1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of order dated 27.01.2023 passed by this court in CWP-5213-2020.

2. The counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of order dated 27.01.2023, the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by the respondents by considering the claim of the petitioner. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.
