Petitioners have filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No. 1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners who are under constant threat at the behest of respondent No.6, who in personal capacity as well as through the other officials is constantly harassing and humiliating the petitioners at the behest of certain persons who have filed a complaint against Sahil Goyal who happens to be the son-in-law of petitioners No.1 and 2.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for directing official respondents to take action against the representation dated 01.06.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners

would be satisfied at this stage, if a direction is issued to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to consider/decide their representation dated 01.06.2025 (Annexure P-2).

3. At this stage, Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondent(s)-State of Punjab pursuant to the advance copy of the petition having been sent to the State of Punjab and submits that he has no objection to the said course of action and states that the claim/grievance of the petitioners as stated in their representation dated 01.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) shall be looked into by the respondent authorities within a period of three weeks from today.

4. In view of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the representation, respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali); is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 01.06.2025 (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioners, in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties, within a period of three weeks from today.

5. It is made clear that this order shall also not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
