RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 28.03.2023 passed in CWP-4979-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Harpreet Singh, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 28.03.2023 passed in CWP-4979-2023 has since been complied with. The representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order (Annexure R-1) and claim of the petitioner has been rejected.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
