1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of BNS, 2023 (corresponding Section 438 of Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 452, 506 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act [Sections 325, 326, 201 of IPC added later on and Section 341 of IPC deleted], in a case arising out of FIR No.248, dated 22.06.2024, registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.
