**HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J. (ORAL)**

1. By way of filing the present petition, the petitioner has alleged willful disobedience of the order dated 28.05.2025 (Annexure P-5), passed by this Court in CRWP-5707-2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is presently lodged in Central Jail, Bathinda, Punjab in connection with FIR No.155 dated 16.07.2023, under Sections 302, 34 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 120-B and 212 IPC, added later on), registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

2.1 It is further contended that the petitioner came to know about the illegal activities being carried out in the Jail, as such, he moved a representation to the Director General of Police (Prisons), Punjab (Annexure P-2). Thereafter, the petitioner filed a Civil Writ Petition bearing No.CRWP-5707-2025, whereby, vide order dated 28.05.2025, a direction was by this



Court to the Director General of Police, (Prisons), Punjab, Chandigarh to consider the representation of the petitioner, which was not done within the prescribed period of 04 weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent, while referring to the short reply dated 24.09.2025, submits that a detailed inquiry was conducted and Inquiry Report dated 04.07.2025 has been communicated to the petitioner vide Letter dated 29.07.2025 (Annexure R-1/T). It is further submitted that no substance supported the allegation found in the representation given by the petitioner.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy, as per law and to file an application for revival of CRWP-5707-2025, if so advised.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
