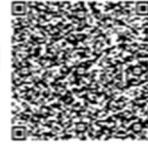

Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for directing learned trial Court to expedite the trial in a case bearing FIR No.168 dated 03.11.2022 (P-1), under Sections 307, 323, 341, 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station PAU, Ludhiana.

(2) There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

(3) On earlier occasion also i.e. 02.06.2025, none came forward to represent the petitioner.



(4) Although, this Court is not going to issue any mandate to learned trial Court; but in view of the specific averment made in para 4 of petition that petitioner is in custody for the last three years, this petition is disposed off with a request to learned trial Court not to grant any unwarranted adjournments to either of the parties.
