The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to complete the process of regularising the petitioners' service considering their qualifications, long-standing service and eligibility criteria, and in terms of the policy decision taken by the Government to take over self-financed college, namely, Amarnath Bhagat Jairam Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Serdha, Kaithal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has not been able to refer to any document on record which could show that the petitioners' services were taken over by the Government pursuant to the decision dated 23.07.2024, Annexue P-3. It only refers to taking over the college as such, there is no mentioning about the service of employees having been taken over, nor has he been able to refer to any material to establish that the petitioners were ever appointed as Assistant Professors in the respondent Department, or were paid any salary by the Government for working in the College. Accordingly, it is not

even *prima facie* established that they were ever appointed in Government service. Resultantly, the writ of *mandamus* to complete the process of regularising their services cannot be issued.

3. Dismissed.
