1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short – BNSS) in FIR No.326 dated 16.09.2024, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, 1860 (Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC added alter on) registered at Police Station Civil Line Jind, District Jind.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
