SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J. (Oral)

1. The present writ petitions have been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue in service without any break in pursuance to their selection and appointment till the time regular incumbents are appointed on the posts on which the petitioners were initially appointed, and not to dispense/replace their services with another contract employee.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) prays for an adjournment stating that arguing counsel is in personal difficulty.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, informs the Court that their requested has already been conceded to by the respondents and has

placed on record the order/written communication dated 02.09.2025, which is taken on record. He further submits that the petitioners are continuing in service and due wages/salaries are being released to them without any default.

4. In light of the above, no cause of action survives in the present petitions as the same has been rendered infructuous.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Pending miscellaneous applications, shall stand disposed of.
