SUMEET GOEL, J (ORAL)

The substantive prayer made in the petition in hand reads thus:-

“It is, therefore, prayed that this revision petition may kindly be accepted/allowed, and the impugned order dated 23.05.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, in Criminal Appeal No.CRA-534-2024 may kindly be set aside, in the interest of justice. It is further prayed that the operation of the impugned order dated 23.05.2025 may kindly be stayed till the decision of the Larger Bench in CRM-M-7799-2025. It is still further prayed that necessary exemption from filling the certified and true typed copies of all the annexures and impugned order dated 23.05.2025 may kindly be granted and downloaded/photocopies which are neat and clean may kindly be taken on record, in the interest of justice.”
