[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-2, dated 28.03.2022, in CRM-M No.12732 of 2022 in case titled as '*Amit*versus*State of Haryana and others*'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-2), reveals that CRM-M No.12732 of 2022, was disposed of by directing the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, to decide the representations filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Although, notice has yet not been issued in the instant case, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 05.09.2022, rejecting the representations filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 05.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
