1. The present revision petition has been instituted under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of appropriate directions to the learned Additional District Judge, Karnal for expeditious disposal of Civil Appeal No.284 of 2023 titled as "Sarwan Singh since deceased through his LRs Vs. Kishor Kumar @ Kishor Chand".

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent had filed a civil suit for mandatory injunction with consequential relief of permanent injunction against the defendant-Sarwan Kumar and his sons which was dismissed by the trial Court on 20.05.2022. The original defendant-Sarwan Kumar unfortunately expired on 15.06.2022, leaving behind the present petitioners as his legal heirs. Thereafter, the petitioners filed civil appeal along with applications for condonation of delay and for stay of the decree. The grievance of the petitioner is that learned appellate Court has been adjourning the matter in stereotype manner without deciding these applications and as a result thereof, the execution Court has issued the



warrants of possession in Execution No.308/2022. Ultimately, he prays for deciding the civil appeal as expeditiously as possible.

3. In view of the order proposed to be passed, notice is not being issued to respondent as it would delay the proceedings besides entailing additional expenses to the respondent.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the paper book.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and learned Additional District Judge, Karnal, is directed to decide the Civil Appeal No.284/2023 along with applications as expeditiously as possible.
