It goes without saying that in case, the petitioner(s)-Workmen approach the competent authority challenging the order of termination as well as approval granted by the authorities, the Labour Court will look into the said aspect keeping in view the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 that as to whether the orders challenged are in contravention of the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.
