The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for directing the respondents to adhere to the notification dated 04.03.2010 issued by respondent No.1 for regularization of illegal constructions raised for religious places (Annexure P-2).

2. Mr. H.S. Baidwan, Advocate appears and files his Memorandum of Appearance on behalf of respondents No.2, 6, 7 and 8/PSPCL in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to pursue their other remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
