1. Learned counsel for petitioner states that matter has been compromised, therefore, she has instructions to withdraw present second petition for quashing of FIR No. 0157 dated 19.11.2021 under Section 498, 406, 342, 506, 323, 149 IPC (later on added offences under Section 379-B, 120-B, 201 IPC and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act) registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1), with liberty to file petition for quashing of aforementioned FIR on the basis of compromise.
