Learned counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of speaking order dated 18.07.2025 passed by Sh. Alok Shekhar, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Deptt. of Finance, which is taken on record.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents, while referring to para-8 of the aforesaid order dated 18.07.2025, which is extracted hereinafter, submits that the claim of petitioner with respect to grant the benefit of notional annual increment has been extended. He further, on instructions from Sh. Paramjit Pandove, Assistant Director, Deptt. of Finance, Punjab, undertakes that the arrears upon revision of pension shall be released in

favour of the petitioner within eight weeks from today.

“ 8.0 Given the foregone, to comply with the orders dated 22.05.2024 of the Hon’ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP-12116-2024, the undersigned hereby orders to recompute the last drawn pay of the petitioner for the purpose of his pensionary benefits by granting him a notional annual increment in lieu of past 12 months completed service and release all the consequential benefits, subject to the outcome of LPA No. 2822 of 2024.”

[3] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[4] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] In case the needful is not done, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition by moving an appropriate application.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
