As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellatant, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.2,33,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Thirty Three Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellatant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellatant the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellatant-Ankush Bansal.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.2,33,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Thirty Three Thousand only) in the name of the appellatant-Ankush Bansal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.04.2025 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellatant's counsel/appellatant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Civil Misc. Applications seeking condonation of delay of 228 days in filing as well as 1 day in refiling the appeal are disposed of in view of the settlement.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
