Vide order dated 03.04.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-18427-2025, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, was directed to look into the representation dated 27.01.2025 submitted by the petitioner (Gurmeet Kaur) and to take appropriate action within two weeks in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel representing the State of Punjab has produced a copy of the speaking order dated 17.05.2025 passed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran in compliance of the directions issued by the coordinate Bench vide order dated 03.04.2025 passed in CRM-M-18427-2025. As per the speaking order, the dispute has been found to be purely of civil nature and even stated that no further action would be warranted on the representation.

3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the petitioner does not wish to press the present contempt petition and shall avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law.



4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule is discharged.
