Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of the revised basic pay of Rs.19,000/- per month to the petitioner effective from 01.04.2020 till 31.08.2023 as per the letter dated 07.01.2021 alongwith 5% annual increment on the revised basic pay as per the policy and also the benefit of the further revised pay of Rs.26,000/- per month effective from 01.09.2023 till 31.07.2024 and then Rs.28,100/- per month effective from 01.08.2024 till date as per the letter dated 14.10.2024 alongwith 5% increment in each year on the revised basic pay alongwith arrears with interest @ 12% per annum.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated nil (Annexure P-7) but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2- The Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairman, District Information Technology Society, Bhiwani, Haryana is directed to consider and decide the representation dated nil (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned State Counsel does not have any objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated nil (Annexure P-7) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of two months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of one month.
