1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.0131, dated 23.08.2020, under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427, IPC, registered at Police Station Kharar, Distt., SAS Nagar, (Annexure P-1).

On the very outset, counsel for the petitioner produces copy of the order dated 24.01.2025, passed by learned JMIC, Kharar, and submits that on account of the fact that challan was presented beyond the period of limitation, that too, without explaining any reason, as to why it was not presented within the period of limitation, proceedings against the petitioner have been dropped.
