The order dated 21.2.2012 required the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioners on notional basis and grant them consequential benefits after re-fixation.

Reply to the petition has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. It indicates that needful has been done and Annexure R-5 indicates that necessary payments have been remitted to the Bank accounts of the petitioners.

Having regard to the aforesaid, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
