The respondent-plaintiff had filed a suit for declaration to the effect that the order dated 25.11.1994 censuring the services of the plaintiff for six months and forfeiting the arrears of suspension is illegal. The said suit was decreed and the appeal against the said judgment filed by the present appellants was dismissed.

2. A perusal of the paperbook would show that there is no interim order in favour of the appellants. In spite of the notices sent, the respondent has not been served.

3. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that in view of the above, present appeal be disposed of at this stage but liberty be granted to the appellants to revive the appeal, in case, any cause of action survives.
