1. On 22.09.2025, this Court passed the following order: -

“1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of orders dated 11.12.2021 and 13.12.2022 whereby he has been made to retire w.e.f. 31.12.2021.

2. The petitioner joined Punjab Police as Constable on 21.08.1989. He was promoted as Head Constable in 2001. He was further promoted as Assistant Sub-Inspector (Local Rank) in 2012. The respondent, in 2021, constituted a Committee to review service record of the petitioner. The said Committee recommended his premature retirement. The respondent issued notice dated 14.09.2021 proposing his premature retirement. He filed his explanation, however, respondent vide order dated 11.12.2021 ordered to retire him with curtailed pensionary benefits. He made representation against order of premature retirement. The said representation came to be dismissed vide order dated 13.12.2022. He served legal notice upon the respondent seeking release of full pensionary and retiral benefits. He preferred CWP No.16120 of 2021 seeking directions to respondents to consider his case. This Court vide order dated

17.07.2024 directed respondents to take final decision on his legal notice. The respondent by order dated 16.10.2024 ordered that leave encashment and gratuity shall remain withheld till the final decision of FIR No.155 dated 19.07.2018 registered against him under Section 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station, Moga. He has been acquitted vide judgment dated 27.03.2025 passed by Special Judge, Moga.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks short accommodation to get complete instructions from his client.

4. Adjourned to 24.09.2025.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
