1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of order dated 13.03.2024 passed by this court in CRWP-2371-2024; along with certain other prayers.

2. Notice of motion.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent and has submitted that though the action has already been taken in the matter and the contentions raised in the criminal writ petition were duly verified by the Deputy Commissioner, however, no bounded labourers were found at the place mentioned by the petitioner. Not only that, even report to that effect was sent to the Registrar of this court, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

4. In view of the above, this court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
