1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing the official respondents to take necessary strict legal action against the respondent/accused for committing cheating/forgery with the petitioner and extorting money for sending the petitioner abroad as neither any accused has been arrested nor the recovery of amount has been made from the accused person. Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to conduct the effective investigation for arresting the accused person and for making the recovery in FIR No.634, dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) after considering the fact that the petitioner has approached from pillar to post as well as by submitting written



application (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.3 but no action has been taken knowingly that the accused person have paid the money extorted from Deepak, who was also accompanying the present petitioner and victim of the accused like the present petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that neither investigation is being conducted in the FIR registered and nor accused has been arrested so far.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions has submitted that the investigation is already going on and would be completed expeditiously.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition is disposed of. Investigating Agency concerned is directed to conclude the investigation in free and fair manner within a period of two months from today in accordance with law.
