2. Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions and Annexure P-3 is ordered to be taken on record.

3. Registry to do the needful.

4. Disposed of.

MAIN CASE

The instant petition under Section 528 of BNSS has been filed with a prayer to direct the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against the Halka Patwari i.e. respondent No.6 as till date no action has been taken against the erring official.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had moved the representation to the competent authorities for taking appropriate legal action but no action thereon has been taken. He had moved the representation (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.3, but till date no action thereon has been taken to redress the grievance of the petitioner. He

submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3- The Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 29.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and at the very outset, submits that the representation (Annexure P-2) is being considered by the concerned authorities and it will be disposed of in accordance with law expeditiously.

5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- The Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 29.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.

6. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.

7. Disposed of.
