1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-13), passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition. However, he submits that the matter is pending since 2013, therefore, time bound directions be issued for the decision of the partition matter.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Sanjeev Kumar, Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Sampla, Rohtak, submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid course being adopted.

4. In view of above, the instant civil writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, considering the fact that the partition proceedings are pending since 2013, the Assistant Collector concerned shall make an earnest endeavour to conclude the partition proceedings within a period of

one year from the date the parties appear before him. The parties are directed to appear before Assistant Collector concerned on 23.04.2025 or any other date fixed by Assistant Collector concerned.
